## MAN'S DEATH RULED ACCIDENTAL

NEWPORT, N.H. (AP) — An autopsy shows a Claremont man found dead in woods in neighboring Newport last week died of a head injury, probably from falling down an embankment, police said.

Lt. James Burroughs said there's no reason to suspect the death of James Denis, 59, was anything other than a tragic accident.

Denis has been reported missing three days before his body was found near a popular fishing spot on the Sugar River on July 6.

His body was found at the bottom of a rocky embankment where police believe he fell about 10 feet before hitting his head on a rock.
