Police resume search for clues in 3-year-old case

MONTGOMERY CENTER — Vermont State Police and canine search teams continued to scour the Montgomery woods today, hoping to link the discovery of a pair of blue jeans to the disappearance of a local teenager.

Personnel searched the areas near South Brook Road and Gibou Road, seeking clues into the 2004 disappearance of Brianna Maitland. She vanished after finishing work at The Black Lantern Inn, a restaurant in Montgomery village, March 19, 2004.

A hiker found a pair of blue jeans last week in the vicinity of today's search. Forensic tests aimed at determining if the jeans belonged to Maitland, who was 17 when she disappeared March 19, 2004, are being conducted at the Vermont Forensic Laboratory in Waterbury.

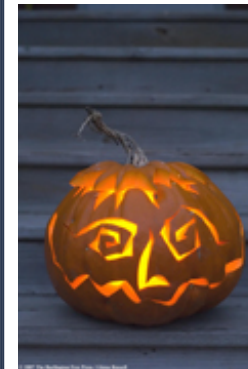
