

Missing woman found in Coos County

Millsfield – A Walpole woman who had been reported missing Friday was found late last night near Clear Stream in this remote area east of Dixville Notch.

Deborah A. Naticchioni, 51, had been seen by several people along Route 26 yesterday morning and calls were made to state police because of concern for her.

Her car was located on the side of Route 26 and a search was launched, involving personnel from Fish and Game, state police, New England K9 Search and Rescue and Upper Valley Search and Rescue.

According to Fish and Game Lt. Todd Bogardus, Naticchioni was found at about 11:15 p.m. by conservation officers Mark Hensell, Chris Egan and the department's dog, Poacher.

"She was out in the woods, near a stream, about a quarter mile from the last house where she had been seen," he said. "She was in good condition, but suffering from a medical condition that led to this."

She was taken for treatment at Upper Valley Connecticut Hospital in Colebrook.
